## 1. Admission Requirements

Chinese Language Learning	Diploma equivalent to a Chinese secondary school certificate
Undergraduate	Diploma equivalent to a Chinese secondary school certificate, HSK 4, pass of first year trial study
Master's	Bachelor's Degree or equivalent, 2 recommendations by associate professors or above
Ph.D.	Master's Degree or equivalent, 2 recommendations by associate professors or above
General Scholar	More than 2 years of formal university education, studying on relevant subjects
Senior Scholar	Master's Degree or associate professorship and above, studying on a specific topic

## 2. Schedule

- (1) Language Learning Fall: Application deadline is July 15; entry date is September 1.
- (2) Language Learning Spring: Application deadline is January 15; entry date is March 1.
- (3) Degree Study Fall: Application deadline is June 30; entry date is September 1.
- (4) Summer Chinese language course is available from July to August.

The above dates are for reference only. In case of discrepancy, the actual time on admission notices shall prevail.

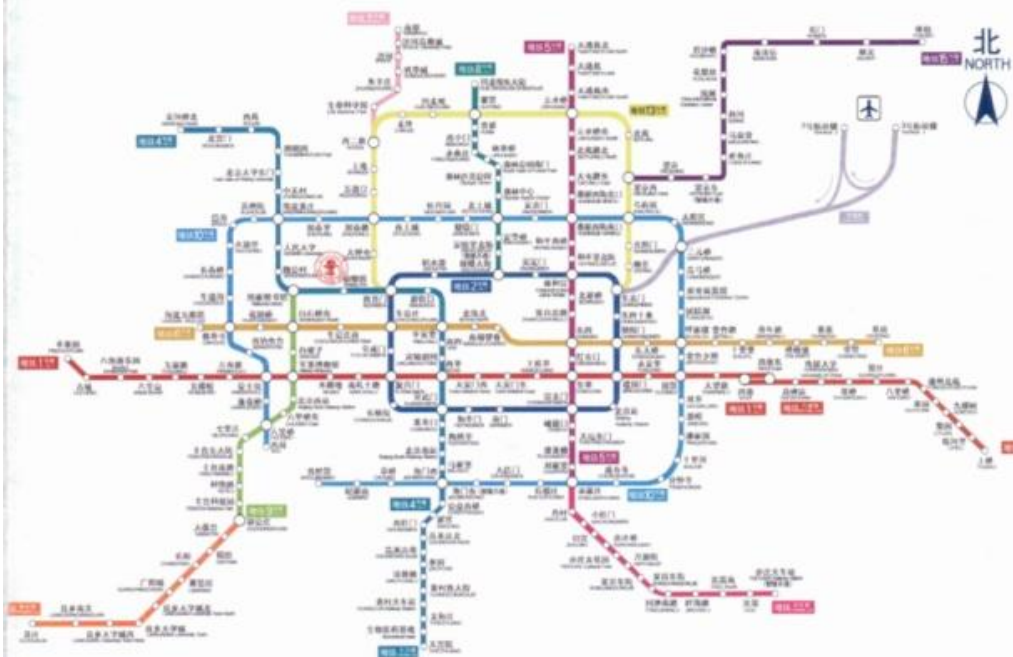
- (1) Application Form completely filled up;

- (4) Notarized diploma and transcripts in English or Chinese (originals should be produced at registration);

Applicants for Master or PhD programs should provide the following documents:

- (5) Two recommendation letters by associate professors or above;
- (6) Study plan.

## **Chinese Government Scholarship---Chinese University Program**

It's a full scholarship program established by Ministry of Education of China to support Chinese universities to recruit outstanding students for graduate studies in China.

### **Program duration and Language of Instruction**

- I. 2-3 years for master's programs; 3-4 years for doctoral programs
- II. For programs in Chinese medium: applicants without HSK-4 certificate should study 1 year Chinese at our university (also provide with the scholarship).  
For programs in English medium: applicants are not required HSK certificate

### **Scholarship Coverage**

- I. Waiver of tuition fee and on-campus accommodation fee etc.
- II. Monthly living allowance 1,700 CNY for master; 2,000 CNY for doctor
- III. One-off settlement subsidy after registration 1,500 CNY/Person
- IV. Comprehensive Medical Insurance

### **Eligibility**

- I. Foreign citizen, in good health
- II. Not be a registered student in Chinese universities at the time of application; or be a graduate from Chinese universities for more than one year;
- III. Be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for master's programs
- IV. Be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for doctoral programs

### **Application procedure**

- I. Applicants should complete the Application Form from Chinese Government Scholarship, submit online <http://www.csc.edu.cn/laihua> and print it out. Note: our agency No. is 10004.
- II. Applicants must provide the following documents(in duplicate, in Chinese or English) to Beijing Jiaotong University (BJTU) at the same time before March 31
  1. Application Form for Chinese Government Scholarship
  2. Highest diploma (notarized photocopy). Prospective diploma winners must submit official proof of student status by their current school. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.
  3. Academic transcripts: Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English Translations.
  4. A Study plan or Research Proposal in Chinese or English with a minimum of 800 words
  5. Two letters of recommendation from professors or associate professors
  6. Foreigner Physical Examination Form (photocopy)

  7. Photocopy of passport
  8. Photocopy of HSK-4 (if any)
